ORIGIN / HISTORY

US origin. A dwarf high-alpha variety bred by the American Dwarf Hop Association in the U.S. Released in 2003.

AGRONOMICS

Resistant to powdery mildew.

ACID COMPONENTS

Alpha Acids	13 – 17% w/w
Beta Acids	4.0 – 6.0% w/w
Cohumulone	26 - 33% of alpha acids

OIL COMPONENTS

Total Oil	1.5 – 2.5 mls/100 grams
Caryophyllene	10 - 15% of whole oil
Farnesene	<1% of whole oil
Humulene	15 - 25% of whole oil
Myrcene	35 - 50% of total oil
